BASIC TRUTH

STEP 1 // VIDEO:

- Watch the Revision Kids video via the link that is provided.

STEP 2 // ACTIVITY:

- What you need: Paper + crayons/markers
- What you do:
 - Encourage your kids to draw a picture of something good friends do together..
 - As they work, ask them: what are some things good friends do?
- What you say: Ask, "Who can tell me what it means to influence someone? Did you know that you are influenced by others whether you know it or not? Some people can influence you to do good things, while some can influence you to do bad things. That's why it's important to choose your friends carefully. If someone is always unfriendly and hurting you or not being nice, you might need to protect yourself and kindly walk away and not talk to them. If you struggle to know what the correct thing is to do, talk to a trusted adult to help you deal with the situation.

STEP 3 // LESSON:

- What you say: [Start by reading the monthly memory verse] "Our memory verse tells us that our actions and words are a huge deal in friendships. True friends learn to love each other through good times as well as rough times. They don't run away when things become difficult. Instead, they stick with you when you need them the most. That's why it's important to choose your friends carefully. One way to do this is by finding friends who love and trust God. When you do, both of you can rely on each other AND ask God for help when problems come your way."
- What you ask: Who are some of your good friends?

STEP 4 // PRAY:

- Close by taking some time to thank God for giving us good friends.
